School News

Parentsportal

Parentsportal is a method for you to access school services and information online. Parents can keep up-to-date with developments at their child's school, arrange parents' evening appointments, check attendance, and even read reports online – all at a time that suits you. Over half of our parents/carers have signed up, but our aim is for all parents/carers to have registered and use this regularly to keep up to date. The app subscription runs out this week and is NOT being renewed and so it is important that everyone is signed up to Parentsportal so they are up to date with school news.

How to register with parentsportal.scot:

To register with parentsportal scot please go to parentsportal scot where you either log in using your MyGovScot account, or if you don't have an account you can register for your MyGovScot account.

Alternatively you can download the app at Apple App Store or Google Play Store.

Once registered you will be prompted to "Link Your Child". In order to link to your child, the data you provide during the sign-up process must match the data that your child's school holds.

You can find answers to frequently asked questions on the parentsportal.scot website. Our school office staff will also be happy to help you.

Flu Vaccinations

Flu Vaccinations Flu vaccinations will take place in our school on Wednesday 15th November. The flu vaccine is usually given as a painless nasal spray and is a safe way to help protect your child against flu. It should start to protect most children against flu about 10-14 days after being vaccinated and will reduce the risk of your child getting flu or spreading it to family and friends who are at greater risk from flu. Consent forms and information about this year's flu vaccine have been sent home to parents and carers of school children on their return to school. 

Attendance

We understand that at times pupils are required to be absent from school through illness and we support parents in ensuring pupils do not return to school too early – we ask that if your child has vomiting or diarrhoea, that you wait until they are clear of any symptoms for 48 hours before returning to school to help prevent infecting others.

However, we would encourage parents not to keep their child off school for other reasons. 17% of our school roll have attendance less than 90%. The graphic below shows the impact this can have. We are keen to work with parents and carers to encourage regular attendance at school – please contact the school if we can help or support you in any way.
