At St. Cuthbert's Primary School we recognise the need to reduce the 'Cost of the School Day' for all our pupils and particularly for our pupils who are already experiencing poverty.

This overview provides information on how we are tackling this important issue.

#### School Trips

- Average cost of school trips is  $\pounds 8$
- School trips are subsidised for all pupils in receipt of free school meals or living in SIMD 1/2
- P7 Residential Trip reduced from 5 days to 4. Cost can be paid in installments.

# Eating at School

- Approximately 15 pupils in attendance at school breakfast club 8:30am - 8:45am daily
- All classes have breakfast / snack bags
- 21% pupils in receipt of Free School Meals ParentPay stops recognition of FME pupils
- Healthy snacks/fruits are provided for those pupils who do not have a snack at interval
- To reduce pressure put upon families, Birthday • Cakes are not allowed to be brought to school



#### **Fun Events**

- Fun events are planned by staff, pupils and our PC
- During seasons of Lent and Advent school encourages fundraising. Changes have been made to donations only so no one is excluded.
- Parent Council provide two discos per year for all pupils to • attend
